- 1. Full Membership:**
All registered, financial members.
- 2. Life Membership:**
Such persons or classes of persons as the URAC Ltd Board may recommend and the Council approve. (See rules below)
- 3. Honorary Life Membership:**
Such persons as the URAC Ltd Board may recommend and approve.
- 4. Temporary Membership:**
Such person or classes of persons who may be approved by the URAC Ltd Board for membership for a period not exceeding three months.

Auxiliary Membership:	no longer applicable after 10th July 2006
Graduate Membership:	no longer applicable after 10th July 2006
Staff membership:	no longer applicable after 10th July 2006

6. URAC Life Membership Rules

ELIGIBILITY

The following members will be eligible for URAC Life Membership:-

- (1) Members who have paid in total six or more annual full-membership fees to URAC Ltd.
- (2) Such person, persons or group of persons as may be unanimously decided upon by the URAC Ltd. Board

(b) FEES

- (1) Any person who is eligible under paragraphs (1) or (2) above may become a life member upon application to the URAC Ltd. Board and upon payment of the current nomination fee, provided that:
 - (i) He or she has paid annual full membership subscriptions to the URAC Ltd. for at least six years in total. For the purposes of this clause, the following guidelines apply:-
 - (a) Two years part-time membership of the W.I.E. Students Association will be deemed equivalent to one year full-time membership.
 - (b) No external (auxiliary) membership of the URAC Ltd prior to July 2006 will be deemed equivalent to any year of full-time membership.
 - (c) In other instances where a lesser fee than the URAC Ltd. full-time membership fee applies, the period of equivalent full-time membership will be calculated in the same proportion as the fees paid to the equivalent full-time fee in the same year of membership
 - (ii) Where he or she has paid any such annual subscriptions then upon further payment of an amount representing the number of subscriptions at the current rate required to bring the total number of subscriptions paid to six; or
 - (iii) where he or she has not paid any such annual subscriptions, then upon payment of an amount equivalent to six annual subscriptions together with the current entrance fee.
 - (iv) where he or she has paid annual subscriptions for more than six years and includes the current subscription, payment of an amount representing the current year's subscription shall be refunded to the member on admission to life membership.

(c) HONORARY LIFE MEMBERSHIP

Persons who have rendered distinguished services to URAC Ltd over an extended length of time, which in the opinion of the URAC Ltd. Board are deserving of Honorary Life Membership, may be so honoured upon the resolution of not less than 75% of the URAC Ltd. Board.
